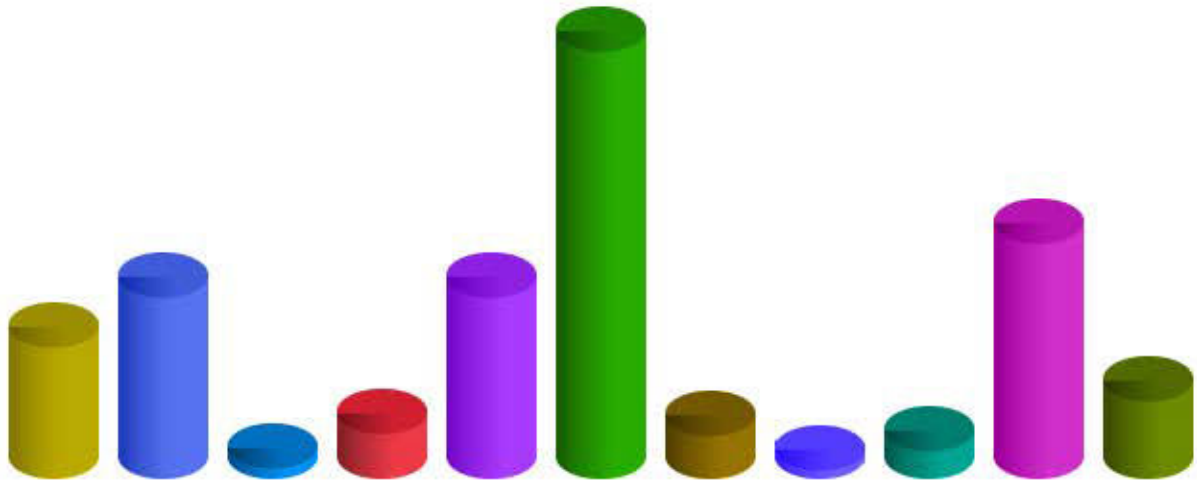

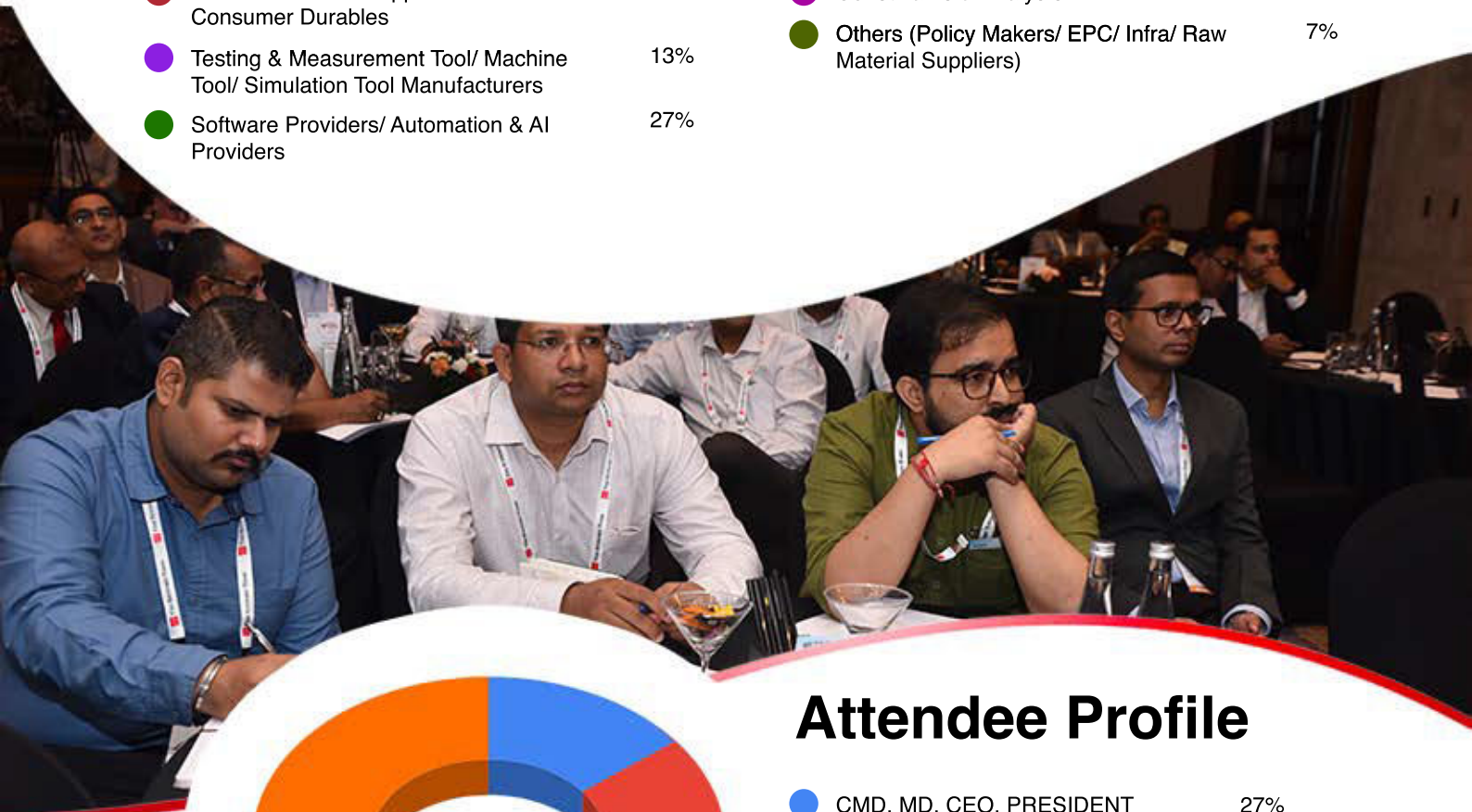

- Paper-based processes: Still used in about 20% of companies to capture just data
- Spreadsheets, emails, SharePoint: Not standard metadata for analytics
- IT systems: Disparate & lead to spaghetti
- AI/ML based analytics: only 25% of implemented
- Structured, semi-structured, unstructured data

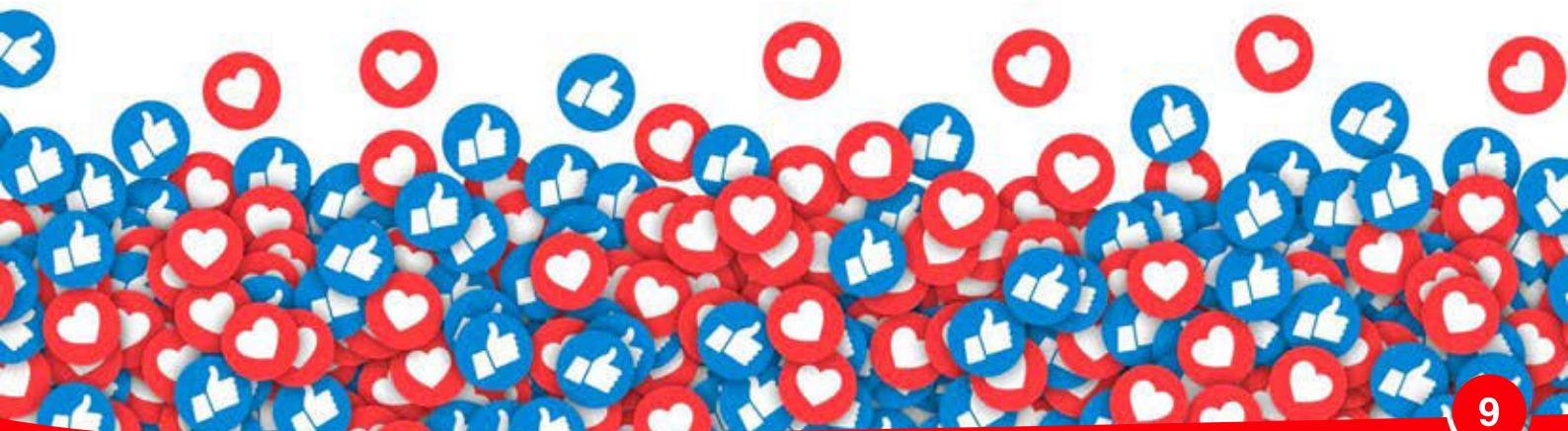
